

NEET 2018 Analysis

DETAILS OF NEET 2018

NEET 2018 was conducted in one paper consisting of 45 questions each from Physics and Chemistry, and 90 questions from Biology, which consists of Zoology and Botany subjects (In all, there were total 180 questions). The exam was conducted on 6th May from 10:00 am to 01:00 pm. **The duration of test was 3 hours.**

OVERALL MARKS DISTRIBUTION

The paper had 180 questions each worth 4 marks. All questions were objective type with single correct option. If we talk about subject wise, then there were 45 questions from Physics and Chemistry, and 90 questions were from Biology (Zoology and Botany sections of Biology).

CONCLUSION

The difficulty level of the paper was from easy to moderate, and this year, the chemistry and biology questions were direct and simple. "Both chemistry and biology section questions were easy to answer and 70-80 per cent questions were from the syllabus itself". Overall the paper was found to be on almost similar difficulty level as of NEET 2017. Compared to last year Biology was easy and Physics and Chemistry were difficult. Since Physics and Chemistry play crucial role in selection so it is expected that rank wise marks can decrease compared to last year.
